#### Wiscombe Park - Background information

It is useful to understand the structure of Wiscombe Park (now in its 66th year) as this helps with knowing who to approach to enter events.

Wiscombe Ltd, is a management company. Wiscombe is a private estate, and the company have an Agreement with the landowner to hold 12 events arranged over 6 race weekends each year. Wiscombe Ltd is run by volunteers and with Peter Isaac as MD, provide the infrastructure to the organising motor clubs to hold the individual events.

Dorset based Woolbridge MC organise the most events at Wiscombe (including the National Championship (BHC) event). The VSCC event is only open to their members. The Arnold Gimblett event is a "bikes only" meeting. The British Championship weekend is very popular and priority is always given to those competitors competing in the National Championships.

Entries at Wiscombe are limited to 130 - some events will also include bikes/sidecars as well as cars.

All motor clubs now use "on line" entry systems from their web sites. Events usually "go live" for entries about 6/7 weeks before the event. Some clubs advertise the "live date" for a meeting on social media/web site, but others do not.

The problem with promoting the "live date", is that everyone applies in a rush at the same time on multiple devices crashing the web site!


