

## **2025 Wiscombe Park Tillicoultry Quarries Championship - Review**

It has been another record-breaking year at Wiscombe Park. And now we have exciting news – the announcement of the winner of the 2025 Wiscombe Park Tillicoultry Quarries Championship.

It is a 7 Round Championship from which drivers count their best 5 results. Because of the wide range of cars competing, we must judge performances on a “level playing field” - no easy task for our Championship Co-ordinator, Steph Thomas. The method we use is based on the Class records. Points are scored at each round by bettering the bogey time for the relevant Class. We had 58 drivers competing for the title.

And we are very pleased to confirm that our 2025 Champion is Ed Hollier – congratulations! Ed wins the Title for the second time, twenty years after he first won it in 2005 in a 1600cc OMS SC1 – a car in which he also won the 2007 MSA Hillclimb Leaders Champion.
